Report of the Inspection committee on its visit to Proposed University on 30th of May 2013

I. **Introduction** : On the recommendation of the Madhya Pradesh Private Universities Regulatory Commission, Bhopal vide letter no 197/MPNVVVA dt 20/02/2013, the Madhya Pradesh Government vide its letter no 487/81/CC/13-38 dt 21/03/2013 has issued letter of intent (LOI) to M/s. H.K. Kalchuri Education Trust Bhopal for establishment of a private university namely LNCT UNIVERSITY. The Trust has submitted its compliance report to the Regulatory commission vide letter no NIL dt 17/05/2013. Accordingly, the Chairman, Regulatory Commission has constituted to asses and verify the physical and academic infrastructure for the proposed University.

II. **Background of the Trust :**

H.K. Kalchuri Education Trust came into existence on 13th January 1999. The Trust is registered under Section 4 of Madhya Pradesh Public Trust Act, 1951 and registered at S.D.O. & Registrar, Public Trust, The. Huzur, Dist. Bhopal vide Registration No. 11/B-113/97-98.

The Trust is pioneer in establishing the *Very First Private Engineering College* in the then state of Madhya Pradesh at Bhopal in 1993 in the name of *Lakshmi Narain College of Technology (LNCT)*.

Since last 20 years, the Trust has sprawled its wings to many cities of M.P. & C.G. and established various Engineering, Management, Pharmaceutical, Homoeopathy, Nursing and Medical Institutions, as detail hereunder :



VIII. Specific Recommendations of the Committee :-


On the basis of overall observations, the Committee recommends to be Regularity Commission for establishment of the private University namely LMC T University at Bhopal.


