- > There is a healthy gender mix among the students.
- Research culture is yet to be established
- Good practise of Project based teaching and learning
- > During interaction with students it was informed by them that they are procuring raw materials for projects, assignments and highresolution scanning and printing facility etc.
- > Food quality for students in the mess needs to be improved.
- > More numbers of computers and server are required.
- > B. Tech (Mechanical Engineering) and M. Design admission are deferred from 2018-19
- > Internet connectivity needs to be improved.

B. Suggestion of the Committee which require satisfactory compliance by the University

- · Senior Faculty at Associate Professor/Professor Levels should be recruited on priority basis in the departments to maintain cadre ratio.
- Faculty members need to be paid the basic pay and DA as per UGC norms.
- Sports facilities need to be upgraded in the campus.
- Central facilities such as central library, computer centre, canteens and smart class rooms needs to be strengthened.
- Student feedback need to be analysed and appropriate follow up is required.
- Need few shops on campus related to the student requirement.

C. Final Recommendations

The Committee, after visiting various physical infrastructure, central facilities, the academic and administrative units, verification of relevant documents pertaining to academic programs, and taking into account the inputs received during interaction meetings with Faculty, Students and Non-teaching staff, unanimously recommends granting approval to the Avantika University, Ujjain, subject to compliance of the suggestions as in Part- IV (B) above.
